

SERMON NOTES

In John 11:28-44, Jesus demonstrates indignation and compassion for the effects of man's sin on creation; raising Lazarus foreshadows Christ's ultimate compassionate sacrifice to reconcile sinful man to a holy and just God, all for God's glory.

1) Outraged and Grieved (vv. 28-37)

i. What does it mean for Jesus to be deeply moved (v. 33, 38)?

ii. Why was He moved so deeply?

iii. Why did Jesus weep (v. 37)?

2) Raised and Resurrected (vv. 38-44)

i. Lazarus was raised to life.

ii. Jesus will be resurrected as the first born from the dead.
